- References

Font, type size, etc

- Main Heading: Arial 14, bold
- Section Headings: Arial 12, bold
- Sub-headings: Arial 11, bold
- Text: Arial 11 with double spacing

Review Process

Academic Articles will be anonymously peer reviewed by two members of the editorial board

Project reports and personal perspectives will be peer reviewed by one member of the editorial board.

Tables and Figures, etc

Tables and figures should be embedded in contributions in numerical order. These should be labelled and referred to as Table 1, Figure 1, etc.

Contributions will be published on conditional that

- Authors certify that the contribution is their own work
- Authors take responsibility for the accuracy of their work
- Authors have obtained permission to include content that is subject to copyright
